

The Soulard Art Gallery Submission Guidelines:

Accepted artists must submit an operational fee of \$30.

Checks must be made out to: Y.E.H.S.

Artists may submit up to three original watercolors for consideration.

2D artwork must be framed and ready for hanging (no saw tooth hangers please).

Unframed "gallery wrapped" canvasses are acceptable.

All artwork for consideration MUST be submitted via JPEG/JPG image.

File size for each JPEG/JPG cannot exceed 500kb and should be named as such:

Artist's Name_Artwork Title_Dimensions.jpg

(John Smith_Artwork1_16x20.jpg)

Late entries will not be accepted, no exceptions.

Accepted artists must be willing to be filmed and/or must be willing and available to participate in

any press interviews, documentaries, and/or photo releases. Artists must be willing to have their

artwork filmed or included in any press releases, articles or other publications as seen fit by the
